FOREWORD

by Phoebe Lumley, WLCGA President

“2010 is going to be a special year as we celebrate the foundation of the Wiltshire Ladies’ Golf Association 100 years ago.

In February 1910, four ladies from West Wilts and South Wilts met at West Wilts with the idea of forming a County Golf Club. On 10 October, they held their first competition at West Wilts. There were 9 scores returned over 36 holes! At their meeting after play, they elected a Captain, Secretary, and Treasurer and two others as a sub-committee, with delegates from Devizes, Marlborough and Swindon to form the full Committee. Five clubs! And so we had the Wiltshire Ladies’ County Golf Club. In 1933, they became Wiltshire Ladies’ County Golf Association.

The ladies managed to keep the Association going through two World Wars and, by the 1950’s, there were nine clubs playing league matches. Today, there are 23 clubs affiliated to the Association, with 1500 lady and girl members.


The County has coaching and practice in place to bring on players for the first and second teams, as well as a great programme of coaching and competitions for the girls. There are county matches, inter-club matches and individual competitions, all of which bring members together in the game we love. All our clubs very actively encourage not only new players, but especially girls, to participate in competitions.

I was delighted when the Committee agreed to my presenting a new trophy to celebrate the Centenary, to be played in my favourite form of golf. I hope all members will celebrate together and enter the Stableford Foursomes competition when it is held at their club. It is free entry too!

All clubs have contributed material for a Centenary book which will include other items and pictures of historical interest. Also, each club will receive a commemorative Centenary plate. The WLCGA website will have details of other events.

I am so proud that the Centenary year has come during my period as President. I actually celebrate being a member for 50 years too! What wonderful years they have been with so many laughs, matches won and lost, but most of all the friendships made here in Wiltshire and on the broader golf scene.

I look forward to seeing you during the season, and wish you all a happy and successful 2010.”

COUNTY FOURSOMES KNOCK OUT

First round to be played on or before 19th April 2010
FINAL will be played on a neutral course by 25th September 2010

RULES

1. All rounds to be played over 18 holes or to a conclusion. Play should start on the first tee.
2. If two players from different Clubs enter, the Home Club must be nominated on the entry form.
3. A draw will be made by the County Competition Secretary and details of the draw will be forwarded to each club participating in the competition.
4. The match to be played on the course of the first-named players marked by an asterisk on the draw sheet.
5. If there are more than two temporary greens or the course is closed, the match must be rearranged, but still played before the closing date for that round.
6. In cases of bad weather and further play is not possible, the match should be treated as null and void and rearranged, but still played before the closing date for that round.
7. No extensions will be granted.
8. The home pair should ensure that opponents are notified of the starting time and that they are granted courtesy of the course.
9. Handicap allowance: HALF difference of the combined handicaps.
10. Semi finals and final to be played on neutral courses. If the two pairs in the semi-final are from the same club, they may opt to play at home or on a neutral course.
11. Results of each match to be sent, by the winners, to the County Competition Secretary immediately.
12. The trophy will be presented at the County AGM and will be held for one year.

COUNTY SCRATCH KNOCK OUT

First round to be played on or before 26th April 2010

FINAL will be played on a neutral course by 25th September 2010

RULES

1. Entry fee to be paid by 31 October each year.
2. Each team to consist of five players. They may be different players for each round and they may be played in any handicap order. A player can only play for one club throughout the season, which must be stated at the outset.
3. A draw will be made by Officers of the County Committee at the AGM the previous year. The County Competition Secretary will forward details of the draw to each club participating and also post them on the County website www.wlcga.com
4. The match to be played on the course of the first-named club and the Home Captain to arrange the match. Home Captains are requested to give their opponents at least three dates, one of which must be at a weekend and one on a weekday, at reasonable intervals. Team Captains must make every effort to arrange a date between them.
5. Each match to consist of five singles matches, each played off scratch, over 18 holes and to a finish, unless the result of the overall match has already been decided.
6. Play should start from the first tee.
7. If there are more than two temporary greens, or the course is closed, the match must be either played on the opponents' course or rearranged but still played before the closing date for that round.
8. No extensions will be granted.
9. The Ladies' Captain of the Home team to inform the County Competition Secretary of the result immediately after the match.
10. The Semi Finals and Final will be played on a neutral course as arranged by the County Competition Secretary.
11. The trophy will be presented at the County AGM and will be held for one year.

COUNTY HANDICAP KNOCK OUT (New Competition)

Handicap Limits – 10-28

First round to be played on or before 26th April 2010

FINAL will be played on a neutral course by 25th September 2010

RULES

1. Entry fee to be paid by 31 October each year.
2. Each team to consist of five players. They may be different players for each round and they may be played in any handicap order. A player can only play for one club throughout the season, which must be stated at the outset.
3. A draw will be made by Officers of the County Committee at the AGM the previous year. The County Competition Secretary will forward details of the draw to each club participating and also post them on the County website www.wlcga.com
4. The match to be played on the course of the first-named club and the Home Captain to arrange the match. Home Captains are requested to give their opponents at least three dates, one of which must be at a weekend and one on a weekday, at reasonable intervals. Team Captains must make every effort to arrange a date between them.
5. Each match to consist of five singles matches, each played off full handicap, over 18 holes and to a finish, unless the result of the overall match has already been decided.
6. Play should start from the first tee.
7. If there are more than two temporary greens, or the course is closed, the match must be either played on the opponents' course or rearranged but still played before the closing date for that round.
8. No extensions will be granted.
9. The Ladies' Captain of the Home team to inform the County Competition Secretary of the result immediately after the match.
10. The Semi Finals and Final will be played on a neutral course as arranged by the County Competition Secretary.
11. The trophy will be presented at the County AGM and will be held for one year.

COUNTY PRESIDENT'S PRIZE

18 hole Stableford competition for Silver and Bronze Divisions to be played at each Club during the month of June 2010. Entry Fee: £1.50

A copy of the winners' cards (Silver & Bronze) to be sent to the County Competition Secretary by **12th July 2010**, with entry fees. Cheques to be made payable to WLCGA.

Proceeds to be donated to the County Youth Development Fund.

CORONATION MEDAL

18 hole Medal competition for both Silver and Bronze Divisions to be played at each Club during the month of July 2010. Entry Fee: £1.50.

Entry fees and cards for each winner to be sent to the County Competition Secretary by **16th August 2010**. Cheques to be made payable to WLCGA.

COUNTY CAPTAIN'S PRIZE

18 hole Medal competition for both Silver (handicaps 0-20) and Bronze (handicaps 21-36) Divisions, to be played at each Club during the month of August 2010. A Perpetual Challenge Trophy, open to all competitors, will be awarded for the best Scratch Score returned. Entry Fee: £1.50

A copy of the winners' cards (Scratch and Handicap for Silver & Bronze Division) to be sent to the County Competition Secretary by **14 September 2009** with entry fees. Cheques to be made payable to WLCGA.

LUMLEY CENTENARY FOURSOMES (New competition)

18 hole Stableford Foursomes competition, to be played between 1st of May and 18th July 2010.

For 2010 only, the winning pair from each club will compete in a final at North Wilts Golf Club on 11th August 2010 and there will be no entry fee. The names of the winning pair and their score should be notified to the County Competitions Secretary by 31st July 2010.

From 2011 onwards, the winners of this competition will be determined by a card decision and prizes awarded at the AGM and there will be a nominal entry fee.

A DAY SHOULD BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR MIDWEEK AND WEEKEND PLAYERS IN THE SAME WEEK FOR ALL THE ABOVE EVENTS

COUNTY MEDAL CUP

The three best nett scores returned in a EWGA Medal between 1st April and 30th September 2010. If more than one EWGA Medal is played during any month, it is the score from the first medal in which the player competes which will count for this Cup.

Results to be sent to the County Competition Secretary **by 11th October 2010** on the form provided.

(When sending in results for all of the above, please include forenames).

Trophies for the above competitions will be presented at the County AGM and will be held for one year.

RULES GOVERNING COUNTY COMPETITIONS

1. All County competitions should be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as laid down by the R & A and with EWGA regulations governing County Golf.
2. Buggies may be used in all County Competitions provided that the host club has no objection. The onus will be on the player to check with the club beforehand.
3. Up to date Handicap Certificates must be produced.
4. No refunds will be given after the closing date for competition entry
5. Silver Division: Handicap 0-20 Bronze Division: Handicap 21-36
6. Problems have arisen where, because of bad weather, including thunder and lightning, it has not been possible to complete all games in the Scratch, Handicap and Foursomes Knockouts. In order to help Lady Captains or Team Captains and Foursomes players, the following guidelines are issued:
 - a) As soon as lightning is seen, the Ladies' Captain or Team Captain of the home club should inform all players to mark their balls and proceed to the clubhouse. Foursomes players should mark their balls and proceed likewise.
 - b) Wait up to one hour and assess the possibility of play resuming. Both Captains/all four players to agree.
 - c) If play cannot be resumed, the following action should be taken in Scratch Knockout matches:
 - All matches completed should stand and all unfinished matches will be null and void.
 - Captains should arrange a date for the remaining matches to be replayed.
 - Each team will be free to alter its original team subject to the proviso that no player who took part in a completed match may take part in any of the matches to be replayed.
 - d) If play cannot be resumed in a Foursomes Knockout match, the match should be treated as null and void and another day fixed.
 - e) If problems arise in the Scratch, handicap and Foursomes Knock Out Competitions, the County Competition Secretary must be informed. A final decision will be made by the Competition Committee (County Captain, County Vice Captain and County Competition Secretary).
7. If there is a tie in any of the other competitions ie. President's Prize, Captain's Prize, Lumley Centenary Foursomes and Coronation Medal, this will be resolved on the last 9, 6, 3 and 1 holes. In the County Medal Cup, a tie will be decided on the last round played.
8. In all competitions, a player can win both trophies, but may only win one prize. The prize will be given to the player with the next best score.
9. The use of Distance Measuring Devices is not permitted in any County competitions, irrespective of whether there is a local rule allowing their use at the course where the competition is being played.

LEAGUE MATCH RULES

Clubs will be divided into divisions, each division having a maximum number of five teams. Each team shall consist of five players. Matches will be singles, played off scratch. Clubs may enter more than one team. Each team shall play a Home and Away match against every other team in its division.

Annual results shall decide which one club will be promoted or relegated from each division. In the event that a team is withdrawn from a division other than the bottom division of the league, no team will be relegated from the division from which the team withdrew. The top team in the division below will be promoted. This will be replicated in any lower divisions.

The entry fee should be paid by 31st October each year. Home captains are required to give their opponents a choice of at least three dates, one of which must be at a weekend and at least one on a weekday, at reasonable intervals. All matches should be played by 30th September.

Clubs must field teams in strict order of handicap. The penalty for not complying with this rule will be loss of all games affected by this error. Please note: an upward handicap revision takes precedence over a downward handicap revision when players are playing off the same exact handicap.

All Captains must field a team, even though it may be under normal or desired strength. The five lowest handicap players in the club at any time shall constitute the "A" team and shall not be eligible to play in the "B" team matches.

A player can only represent one club in the same season and must comply with current EWGA County golf regulations.

Buggies may be used in League Matches provided that the home club has no objection. The onus will be on the players to check with the club beforehand.

Match Regulations

In the event of "A" and "B" teams from one club being in the same Division in any year, they must play one match against each other **before** they play any other matches, and the other during July of that year.

Team sheets shall be exchanged prior to the commencement of the match. After that, last minute substitutions may be allowed but the new player must play in the place of the player for whom she is substituting – regardless of handicap.

Any player arriving after the reserved tee time, without an explanation acceptable to both team captains, will forfeit her match.

Should a club be unable to field a team of five players, the opposing team will be awarded two points for each match not played.

Scoring 10 points is available for each match. (For each individual game): Win = 2 points, Half = 1 point, Loss = 0 points.

A half may only be recorded and points awarded if a match remains all-square after 18 holes.

In the event of a tie in the total number of points scored throughout the season, results will be calculated by the WLCGA Competition Secretary on matches won, before individual points. In future, should there be a tie even after counting individual points, the team that scored the most away points would be the better team.

All League results are to be notified by the Home team captain to the WLCGA Competition Secretary within 48 hours of the completion of each fixture.

There shall be a Trophy for the winning team in each Division.

Home clubs should host visiting teams with light refreshments.

New clubs accepted into the League shall be given a place in the lowest division in preference to a "B" team from an established club, if the overall size prevents the accommodation of both. In this event, the "B" team occupying the lowest place would be asked to withdraw.

A new 'A' team applying to join shall have priority over the lowest placed existing "B" team in the 5th Division. A "B" team so displaced may re-apply the following year.

Any infringement of the rules governing clubs fielding "A" and "B" teams will result in forfeiture of the points gained in the match concerned. Any problems arising should be referred to the WLCGA Competition Secretary.

Any disputes or requests for rulings should be referred to the County Competition Secretary in the first instance. If she is unable to resolve the matter, it should be referred to the County Committee and their decision will be final.

Course

Home captains at courses with more than 18 holes should notify the away captain as to which combination of holes are to be played, prior to the match date.

The Home team captain has the responsibility to ensure that the course is suitable for play.

If for any reason there are more than 2 temporary greens in play, the clubs may, by mutual agreement, rearrange the match to be played before the end of September. It is the responsibility of the home captain to check with the course manager on the morning of the match.

The use of distance measuring devices is not permitted in League matches, even though there maybe a local rule allowing their use at the course where the match is being played.

Weather

No match may be postponed except:-

If the course is closed, in which case, the Home captain must telephone the other captain 2½ hours before the match is due to start. The match should be rearranged before the end of September.

In the event of more than two temporary greens being in play the club concerned may, by mutual agreement, re-arrange the match before the end of September.

For matches interrupted by the weather, play can only be suspended if there is danger from lightning or there are flooded greens, or for some other reason play is impossible. Agreement to suspend play should be reached by mutual agreement, but in cases of dissent, the Home captain has the final say. Players should mark their balls and leave the course.

If it is not possible to resume play:-

The completed matches stand.

The remaining matches must be completed at a later date, but as soon as it is practical, between the same players, playing in the same order, who must commence at the start of the hole where they marked their balls. If the same players are not available in either or both teams the whole match must be replayed.

If no matches have been completed, the whole match may be re-arranged at a later date, with different team members if necessary.

18 holes must be available for play. If a green or a hole is unplayable and a match is all-square after 17 holes, then the next available hole must be played.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Updated October 2008 (Nomenclature only)

1. **The name of the Association** shall be the Wiltshire Ladies' County Golf Association and is, in this Constitution, referred to as "the Association".
2. **The object of the Association** is :
 - a) to uphold the Rules of the English Women's Golf Association and to maintain, administer and enforce the CONGU system of handicapping.
 - b) to further the interests of both junior and ladies' golf in Wiltshire
 - c) to give support and advice on the running of Ladies' Sections and
 - d) to organise County Matches and such other activities for members as approved by the Committee
3. **The Management of the Association** shall be vested in an Executive Committee, hereafter called the Committee, consisting of the President, Captain, Vice-Captain, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Secretary, Handicap Adviser, Competition Secretary, EWGA South West Delegate, EWGA Standard Scratch Assessor, Junior Organiser, and one nominated delegate from each affiliated club. There shall be a Vice President, normally the outgoing President, who shall stand in for the President if required. All the aforementioned, with the exception of the President, Vice President and Handicap Adviser, shall each have a vote. In the absence of a Club Delegate, the Club Captain may nominate a substitute who shall have a vote, but only one vote per club.

The Officers, together with the Delegates, shall hold at least two Committee meetings a year, minutes to be circulated within four weeks of such meetings. Only Full Members shall be eligible to serve on the Committee and vote at meetings of the Association. A quorum shall consist of three Officers with voting power and six delegates, in addition to the Chairman. Any member serving on the LGU or EWGA Executive Councils may attend Committee meetings but shall have no vote.

The Captain shall be Chairman of all Committee meetings, in her absence the Vice-Captain shall act as Chairman. The Chairman shall have a second casting vote at all meetings. The President and Handicap Adviser shall have no vote.

The Committee shall have power to co-opt any member of the Association, and are empowered to make a bye-law to meet temporary emergencies as they deem necessary, which shall have effect until the next General Meeting.

The Committee will be responsible for the rules and conditions governing all competitions run by the Association, including the Championships and all League matches.

All members shall be bound by the Rules & Regulations of the Association.

Term of Office:-

President	-	3 years
Captain & Vice- Captain	-	2 years

County Handicap Adviser	-	10 years (EWGA regulations)

EWGA SW Delegate	-	4 years (EWGA regulations)
Club Delegates	-	2 years min, 4 years max

Officers not regulated by EWGA or South West regulations may be re-elected for a further term of office.

Deputies may be appointed for the last year of an officer's term of office with a view to taking over that office.

4. The Hon. Secretary shall keep full and correct minutes of all proceedings of the Association which shall be produced at all meetings.
5. The Hon. Treasurer shall keep a full account of all monies received and disbursed. An audited annual balance sheet shall be prepared and laid before the members at the Annual General Meeting.
6. The Officers of the Committee shall be entitled to claim expenses. The President and Captain shall each receive an honorarium, such amounts to be decided at a Committee Meeting.
7. The Annual General Meeting of the Association shall be held in November each year and shall be chaired by the President. In her absence, the Captain shall chair the meeting which is held for the purpose of:
 - (a) confirming the Minutes of the last meeting
 - (b) receiving the Statement of Accounts
 - (c) receiving the Captain's Report and other official reports,
 - (d) ratifying the election of the President, Captain and Vice-Captain as invited by their predecessors and approved by the Committee
 - (e) the election of Officers
 - (f) to consider any Resolutions
 - (g) to approve the amount of the annual payment to be made under Rule 16
 - (h) to consider Any Other Business
8. Twenty eight days notice of any such Annual General Meeting shall be sent in writing for display at each affiliated club of the Association. Accidental omission to give proper notice thereto or the non-receipt thereof by any such person or club shall not invalidate the proceedings of any General meeting.
9. Forty Full Members shall form a quorum at a General Meeting and every question shall be decided by a show of hands, unless a ballot is directed by the Chairman or demanded by no less than six persons. In the event that there is no quorum present within 30 minutes of the advertised commencement, the meeting shall be adjourned for three weeks and notices shall be forwarded for display at affiliated clubs at least fourteen days before such adjourned meeting. No quorum shall be required for such adjourned meeting.
10. Resolutions for the AGM, which may be proposed and seconded by a Club or members of the Association, must be sent in writing to the Hon. Secretary at least two months before the said meeting.
11. Lists of nominees shall be placed in each club 4 weeks before the AGM. No one may be nominated without their prior consent.
12. No Rule of the Association shall be altered or repealed and no new Rule shall be made except by a two-thirds majority of the Full members present and voting at a General Meeting. Any alteration or addition so made to take effect from the date that meeting shall be by a majority decide.
13. Constitution.

Members of the County, both Full and Associate, shall be those who qualify under the EWGA rules for Membership of a County Association.

NOTE: EWGA regulations state - No one shall be a Full Member of more than one County Association.

14. **Extraordinary General Meeting** - The Hon. Secretary shall convene an Extraordinary General Meeting at any time by order of the Committee, or on receiving a requisition to call such a Meeting by twenty-five members of the Association from a minimum of two clubs. Every such requisition shall specify the business for which such a meeting is to be convened and no other business shall be transacted at such a meeting.
15. **Disputes** - A sub-committee, consisting of the President, Captain, Vice-Captain, Honorary Secretary and Immediate Past Captain, shall consider all facts concerning any allegations made against a member or members accused of bringing the game into disrepute and, if necessary, take appropriate action.
16. (a) There shall be an annual payment to the Association of such amount as shall from time to time be approved by the AGM or an EGM of the Association, payable by the individual members as at the following 1st January and collected by the clubs who will forward it to EWGA, along with a list of club members.
- (b) Annual subscriptions become due on affiliation and thereafter on 1st January in each year and must be forwarded to EWGA on or before 1st March each year.
- If any affiliated club shall fail to pay its annual subscription by 1st March in any year it shall not be entitled to be represented on the Committee and its members shall not be entitled to participate in County competitions.
- (c) Any affiliated club wishing to withdraw from the Association shall give notice in writing to the Hon. Secretary not later than 30th September of the current year or it shall be liable for the next year's subscription. A club having complied with this rule and wishing to rejoin shall pay the annual subscription payable under paragraph (a) hereof.
- (d) An affiliated club which has resigned from the Association and wishes to rejoin shall on rejoining pay such re-entry fee as a Finance sub-committee shall from time to time decide.
17. **Publication of Rules** - A copy of the Rules & Regulations of the Association shall be sent to every affiliated club.
18. (a) **County Team** - The Association shall form a County Team to compete in the South West Region of the English Women's Golf Association. All players in this team must be FULL members of the Association. The expenses of this team may be defrayed by the Association to such an extent as may be determined by the Committee.
- (b) The County Team will be selected by the Captain, Vice-Captain and advisers.
19. The Association will operate a County Course Card Scheme whereby members of the Association will be entitled to concessionary green fees at any of the participating clubs.
- Only bona-fide members of Wiltshire affiliated clubs may purchase County Course Cards, which may only be purchased by members who have a CONGU handicap.
20. **Complaints** - All complaints shall be made in writing to the Hon. Secretary who, should she be unable to deal with them herself, shall submit them to the Committee whose decision shall be final.
